The woman in Song of Solomon chapter kept pursuing Her lover after the watchman beat her. The way man in this text is church people who wound you. It can be loved ones who misunderstand you and ignorantly hurt you. It can be spiritual warfare against forces unseen. It can be life itself that can be full of anxieties, severe pressures, and overwhelming deadlines. There were people in this text witnessing her going through suffering. Her pursuit for her lover in spite of her beatings caused them to want to come to her church. They asked her 'show us this fairest of ten thousand.' I want this love you are showing in your relationship conflicts. This woman chose to handle her hurts properly by taking them with her as she chased after her Lover. She made her Lover responsible for her pain (***Psalms 147:3-4***).

So our prayer today should be, God allow me to approach Your throne by Your strength and anointing like this woman who never gave up pursuing You even though she was hurt and disappointed. I want to know You.

Our prayer today should be, God I choose to pursue Your love today through prayer with expensive passionate focus while facing:

- B. Financial hardships
- C. Health problems
- D. Rejection from loved ones
- E. Job conflicts
- F. Children discouragement
- G. Disappointments about myself
- H. Failed expectations with myself and others
- I. Against the stubbornness of my carnal nature
- J. Getting no results in soul winning

Song of Songs 5:6-16 AMPC

[6] I opened for my beloved, but my beloved had turned away and withdrawn himself, and was gone! My soul went forth to him when he spoke, but it failed me and now he was gone! I sought him, but I could not find him; I called him, but he gave me no answer. [7] The watchmen who go about the city found me. They struck me, they wounded me; the keepers of the walls took my veil and my mantle from me. [8] I charge you, O daughters of Jerusalem, if you find my beloved, that you tell him that I am sick from love simply sick to be with him. [9] What is your beloved more than another beloved, O you fairest among women taunted the ladies? What is your beloved more than another beloved, that you should give us such a charge? His appearance is like Lebanon, excellent, stately, and majestic as the cedars. [16] His voice and speech are exceedingly sweet; yes, he is altogether lovely the whole of him delights and is precious. This is my beloved, and this is my friend, O daughters of Jerusalem!

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
